**impatiently** — in a way that shows an unwillingness to wait **puny** — small or unimportant, weak **precious** — of high price or value **stubborn** — not willing to change in spite of requests by others **decent** — fairly good, adequate **irritable** — easily annoyed or bothered **desperate** — in a critical or hopeless situation, ready to do anything **britches** — pants **Reconstruction** — 1867-1877, after the Civil War during the rebuilding of the southern states. **Depression** — 1930s, when there was widespread unemployment, falling wages and prices **pneumonia** — a serious lung disease **furnace** — an enclosed chamber for burning fuel to produce heat **mahogany** — a tree with dark, heavy wood **perspiration** — sweat wispy — having thin, filmy strands

**cottonmouth** — poisonous snake, also called water moccasin
