Jeremiah 29:13: You will find me when you seek me...

Matthew 7:7: Seek and you will find...

2 Chronicles 15:2: If you seek him, if you forsake him...

What does **forsake** mean?

Psalms 9:10: You have never forsaken those who seek you...

Prov. 25:2 It is the glory of God to conceal a matter; to **search** out a matter is the glory of kings.

Is. 45:15 Truly you are a **God who hides** himself, O God and Savior of Israel.

Is. 55:6 **Seek** the LORD while he may be found; call on him while he is near.

Jer. 29:13 You will **seek** me and find me when you **seek** me with all your heart.

Matt. 7:7 ¶ “Ask and it will be given to you; **seek** and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.

2Chr. 15:2 He went out to meet Asa and said to him, “Listen to me, Asa and all Judah and Benjamin. The LORD is with you when you are with him. If you **seek** him, he will be found by you, but if you forsake him, he will forsake you.

Psa. 9:10 Those who know your name will trust in you, for you, LORD, have never forsaken those who **seek** you.

Acts 17:27 God did this so that men would **seek** him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from each one of us.

Heb. 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly **seek** him.

Psa. 63:1 ¶ O God, you are my God, earnestly I **seek** you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

Prov. 2:1-5 ¶ My son, if you accept my words and store up my commands within you, turning your ear to wisdom and applying your heart to understanding, and if you call out for insight and cry aloud for understanding, and if you look for it as for silver and search for it as for hidden treasure, then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God.
